

Creating Camp Menus the Fiji Way

At Fiji camps, everyone cooperates to contribute local produce for camp meals. Monica Raghwan, new Regional Vice President of the South Pacific Region, explains: “When I attended our first Council Ring meeting I learned a whole new meaning to camps when deciding on a menu. It was very creative and cost effective. **We had to go look in our backyards to see what we had.** Cumquats, dried coconuts, lemon leaves for tea, guava, breadfruit, cassava, chilis, eggplant, beans, etc., were found in backyard gardens. Whatever is in season at the time, we use. Once we had a list it was decided that all the citrus would be juiced and frozen to be used at camp. Shanti, our longest-serving member, is usually the supplier of cumquats from her faithful tree. The cumquat skin would be used to make jam. Our Treasurer, Diana, would get her mum to make this for us. Suresh, our current chair, is a champion at making chutney and pickles with star-apples. No camp of ours has ever lacked these. We would consider ourselves lucky if avocados and pineapple were in season during our camp.” Pray about attending the Regional Camp in Fiji in 2013, and find out what God sends to the garden!

European Regional Vice President Robin Shelley writes: “We enjoyed our North-East weekend retreat, which was attended by 56 campers including 16 new people. Many people were blessed, and it was all very encouraging.”
