In July, CFOI President Sue Fairley took a trip to Peru to finalize details for the 10th International Camp coming in August 2012, and to conduct a training camp for Peruvian CFOers. She came back greatly encouraged by the love and excitement she found there. She writes:

"BIENVENIDO A PERU!" These were the words that greeted me wherever I went in Peru – "Welcome to Peru." When I arrived at the airport I was looking for Jorge (RVP for Latin America) because I was to stay with him. When I walked out into the Arrivals area I saw hundreds of Peruvians, all speaking Spanish, many holding up signs of greeting, but although my eyes scanned the whole area I could not see Jorge anywhere. It was a bit overwhelming but I decided it was time to use

my limited Spanish at the information desk. Fortunately I was able to make myself understood and after an announcement over the speaker system, I saw Jorge coming towards me with a huge smile. I was so relieved!!



The highlight of my trip was a weekend of training with leaders from all over Peru. Each of their regions was represented. Fifty-five leaders of all ages gathered at a beautiful retreat centre called La Villa de Paz (House of Peace). Many people had travelled all night on a bus to get there. Their commitment was amazing. This training was only possible because of the generous support of people like you.

Even though I could not communicate with them in Spanish (yet!) I was blessed to have an excellent interpreter and we managed very well. If you have ever tried to make yourself understood in another language you will know what I mean. But when they prayed and sang it was like listening to the angels. It didn't matter that I could not understand all of the words. They were so eager to learn - even those who have been in CFO leadership for many years .

The Peruvians are very excited to host the 10th International CFO camp next year and are hoping that at least 100 of them will be able to attend. This will only be possible if we raise the necessary funds for camperships. Just think how wonderful it will be to enable a brother or sister in Peru to have this experience of a lifetime!!

This year the Board meeting of CFOI was planned to coincide with the ACFO (North American CFO) meetings, to strengthen the Bond of Love among us. Of Pearls and Saints


Miki Moto was 96 years old when Glenn Clark met him in Japan. Glenn was on his first journey around the world in 1954, making connections and beginning the Belt of Prayer. Miki Moto had become rich by mass-producing pearls. Before that, pearl divers had to crack open hundreds of oysters to find one pearl. As we know, pearls are formed when an irritating substance is introduced into the oyster.



Glenn drew the parallel with saints, noting the painful trials that often have produced praying Christians. Miki Moto was getting oysters to produce pearls by introducing perfect little replicas, made from mussel shells imported from America. The oysters are kept in the water under sheltered docks while the pearls form. What if saints could be formed by introducing something carefully designed and lovingly made, a miniature model of what they are meant to be?

Enter Camps Farthest Out. If the government could take farm boys and make an army of soldiers out of them, and Miki Moto could take oysters and get each one to produce a pearl, why don't we create a way to produce praying Christians who can really change the world? Saints are produced by trials, but Glenn had a vision for producing saints through introducing them to Kingdom living in a God-given program, and teaching them to pray in balance in their everyday lives. We continue to this day, spending time in unconditional love and seeing God's healing come into our lives.

CFOI is engaged in training people to train others to continue to provide this nurturing practice ground for producing praying saints. One camp is not enough to produce a group of saints, but with continued care, more praying people are being raised up. Are you in training to be a praying saint? Are you a pearl in the making?

Soundari Alexander, National Council Ring Chair for Sri Lanka, reports that they held another CFO Day in Jaffna on July 2nd, with 75-80 people attending. They did a full CFO program day, and at the Sharing time at the end, "We had priests telling us with tears in their eyes that no has ever blessed them and when people went round touching or not touching them and blessing them, they just felt God blessing them. Our hearts are full of gratitude."
