Who We Are

- CFO is a worldwide non-denominational Christian network of Camps, Retreats and Leadership Training.
- We are committed to a world of Peace through a conscious creative practice of the presence of God in our daily lives.
- We offer a unique means of learning the arts of praying, loving, and creative living to build a world of Peace.

The Uniqueness of CFO

- CFO provides an experience in finding the wholeness of the spiritual life. Spirit, mind and body are developed together in harmonious relationship. The CFO program is pointed toward experiencing the Kingdom of Heaven on earth. In CFO we live in the Kingdom twenty-four hours a day: at meals, during leisure time, at resting time, during discussions, prayer groups, when alone and when with friends. In this way we gain experience in a new way of living which is both natural and normal.
- This new way of living is centered in the unconditional love of God through Jesus Christ and is rooted in the consciousness of the presence of God. This experience continues as long as the principles of living taught by Christ are applied. After a CFO experience, attendees go home prepared to apply these principles in every avenue of their lives– business, home, politics, recreation, churches – thereby contributing to the building of a world of Peace.

We Believe

- The great law at the center of ALL is that each individual is a whole being, but incomplete when separated from that Still Greater Whole in which we live, move and have our being.
- n Spiritual Laws can be learned only through actual experience.
- n To attain world peace, we must work to attain in our own souls the inner spirit of peace. Before we can attain harmony of nations we must attain harmony of individuals. That harmony must begin in each individual soul.

Action Principles

- n CFOers go all the way out in accepting the teachings in the Sermon on the Mount as absolutely practical, knowing that the promises of Jesus are absolutely true.
- n CFOers assume that failure to experience the power in these teachings and promises lies in us and not in Jesus; that by getting ourselves, our self-wills, our self-centeredness, and our self-consciousness out of the way, we can make room to let God in.
- n Leaders in CFO are individuals who talk of and about God, and who actually abide in God through Christ so genuinely and so profoundly that Christ becomes 'contagious' to others.

Our History

- Glenn Clark, the founder of CFO, was an English professor and highly successful athletic coach. While on the 'Island Farthest Out' in the Atlantic Ocean off the eastern coast of the United States, he had a dream of groups of people meeting together over a period of time to experience the wholeness of the spiritual life through learning how to practice the presence of God in every area of their lives.
- Dr. Clark layman, eminent author, professor, philosopher, Christian mystic, man of prayer and faith – believed men and women could become *Athletes of the Spirit*. By that he meant that to live in the Kingdom of God, here and now, we must enter into training as does a physical athlete. It seemed to him that "farthest out" was symbolic of going "all the way" in seeking God and the laws of His Kingdom. Thus, our name, Camps Farthest Out.
- The first CFO camp was held at Lake Koronis, Minnesota, USA, in 1930. Today there are CFO camps and retreats held throughout the United States and Canada under the Assn. of Camps Farthest Out, North America. Camps in Africa, Australasia, South Asia, East Asia, South America and Europe are part of CFO International.

You Are Invited

- CFO has no membership fee. All who attend CFO may become a part of CFO by their participation through body, mind and spirit.
- CFO is lay oriented and directed. Clergy of all churches are welcome and invited. Some of them are CFO leaders. However, the camps are lay camps, and the emphasis is on personal experience, not doctrine. All are welcome.
